## Bill Rules Out School Job for Sex Offenders

SACRAMENTO, March 13 (P) A bill aimed at keeping persons convicted of sex offenses out of schools was introduced today by Assemblyman H. Allen Smith (R) Glendale.

It provides that the State or a county Board of Education shall not issue credentials to anyone convicted of a sex offense—and that anyone convicted shall lose credentials.

It also specifies that a governing board of a school district shall neither hire nor retain in the school system anyone who has been convicted of such an offense. Los Angeles Times 1952 03 14, pg 16
