# New Sex Offense Law Operative

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 19. (AP)—Convicted sex offenders in California have 30 days to register with police. Registration forms within 30 days after entering the State. The law becomes effective today. Failure to register is punishable by fine or imprisonment. Registration records will not be open to public inspection.
