Special Squads Called; Description Given

Five police cars and two homicide officers were assigned yesterday to press the search for Dorothy Gordon, 9-year-old Negro child, believed to have been kidnaped by a middle-aged white man last Tuesday near the Cornerstone Baptist Church.

Detective Lieutenants Jack Dwight and Harry Fremont were assigned by Inspector David Davidson yesterday to augment investigators from the District Attorney's office in hunting the pair.

The officers reported they had obtained a detailed description of the suspect enabling them to partially identify him through the police index of sex offenders.
